This funding will be used to

- Increase academic achievement in English to 80% A-C
- Close the gap in Year 3 Reading – NMS
- Increase student engagement and student attendance in P-6 to 92%
- Increase student engagement reduce the % of disciplinary absences by 20% from 2016

Our initiatives include

- Development of a whole school understanding of systematic Curriculum delivery and implement sequential curriculum plan
- Capability Development for teachers of curriculum development and delivery
- Collaborative planning and unpacking the curriculum – Consistency in planning process
- Building teacher capability of analysis of student performance data to inform curriculum planning and delivery process
- Targeted strategies to support response to intervention and curriculum differentiation Tiers 1-3
- Targeted teaching strategies for learning to read and reading to learn – The Big 6
- Increased student engagement in curriculum, attendance, Positive Behaviours for Learning and whole school well-being

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Continued employment of Master Teacher (\$14,000)
- Continued employment of Speech Language Pathologist (\$30,000)
- Student Engagement Support Teacher (\$73,000)
- Release for collaborative planning, student performance data analysis, moderation and evaluation (\$110,000)
- Targeted Curriculum strategies resources and programs (\$20,000)
- Wages and Resources for improving attendance, PBL, and Well-being programs (\$55,000)
